Teresa Ann Perkins

A loving wife and mother, devoted daughter, sister and friend, Teresa Ann Perkins died on Friday, February 17, 2017 in Terra Bella.

Teresa was born in Porterville, CA, on March 8 1948. She was 68 years old.
